

When To Call Your Provider — 2nd Trimester

Please contact your healthcare team if you're experiencing any of these symptoms:

- Fever at or over 100.4° F or 38° C
- Painful cramping
- Bright red vaginal bleeding
- Severe, constant headaches especially if accompanied by any changes in your vision
- Persistent vomiting or diarrhea, or
- The inability to keep liquids down due to nausea or vomiting, resulting in a decreased amount of urine
